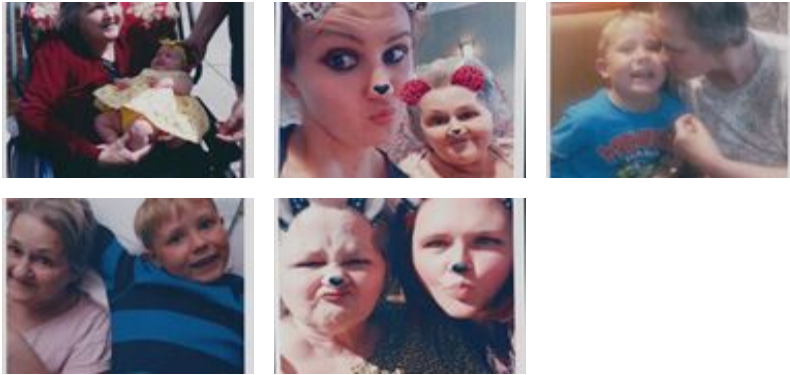

Er the Gobble-uns'll git you*

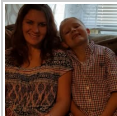
