



C. Don Hyleman

March 16, 1932 - April 25, 2010

Spartanburg – C. Don Hyleman, 78, of 124 Mustang Dr., Wellford, SC, passed away on Sunday, April 25, 2010 at Spartanburg Regional Medical Center after a long illness. He was the son of the late Grover Lee Hyleman and Zelia Chapman Mabry and the step-son of the late Oris Mabry of Cowpens.

Mr. Hyleman served in two branches of the US military from 1950-1970. He was in the USMC for nine years and retired from the USAF after 11 years of service. He was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross and the Purple Heart.

He was the owner of C. Don Realty & Auction Co. in Spartanburg and was one of the founders of Fort Prince Memorial Gardens in Wellford, SC. Mr. Hyleman was very involved with the Hejaz Shrine Temple and was a member of the Masonic Lodge # 143 at New Prospect, SC.

Mr. Hyleman was married to the late Joanne Taylor Hyleman and Iris Rich Hyleman. He is survived by two sons, Dan Hyleman and wife Brenda of Chapin, SC and Joey Hyleman and wife Donna of Startex, SC; one step daughter, Sylvia Mease of Gaffney; a brother, Lee Mabry and wife Laura of Spartanburg; a sister, Lynne Williams and husband Ervin of Inman, SC; six grandchildren and five great grandchildren. He was predeceased by one daughter, Teresa Hyleman.

A celebration of his life will be 3:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 27th following visitation at 2:00 p.m. at Living Waters Funeral Home and Crematory officiated by the Rev. Dr. Keith Taylor and Rev. Ron Smalley.
