



Dorothy McKnight Wallace

Spartanburg, SC - Dorothy McKnight Wallace, 88, died Monday, January 21, 2013 at Park Place Assisted Living. Mrs. Wallace, a native of Murfreesboro, TN, was the beloved wife of Robert F. Wallace for 66 years and was the daughter of the late Andrew and Sara Bragg McKnight.
