Boiling Springs – James Howard Trisler of Boiling Springs, SC passed away Thursday, February 11, 2016 at SRMC. He was the loving husband for 48 years to Dianne Gain Trisler and the son of the late Carl Jr. and Mildred Straight Trisler.

A native of Fairmont WV, James graduated from East Fairmont High School in WV in 1961. He retired from the Fairmont WV Fire Dept. in 1991 after 20 years of service. He served in the WV National Guard from 1965-1971. Mr. Trisler also worked as a jailor for Spartanburg City and maintenance for the SC Dept. of Transportation. He was a Master Mason with his Masonic Lodge. He volunteered for 24 years in the Special Education Class at Bethel United Methodist Church in which his son is a member. He also volunteered at the Senior Wellness and Health Center in Spartanburg, SC where he delivered for Shop N' Cart.

In addition to his wife, survivors include two sons, Scott and Crystal, and Michael of Spartanburg; grandchildren Patrick Trisler of Cowpens and Allison Trisler of Duncan, SC; a brother, Carl Thomas Trisler of Finksburg, MD; two uncles, three nieces and two nephews.
