GREER – Jean Florence White, 96, passed away peacefully in her home surrounded by family on February 25, 2021. A Florida native, Jean was born October 14, 1924 in Jacksonville and, on Christmas eve in 1942, married a handsome Navy aircraft mechanic, Frederick C. White.
