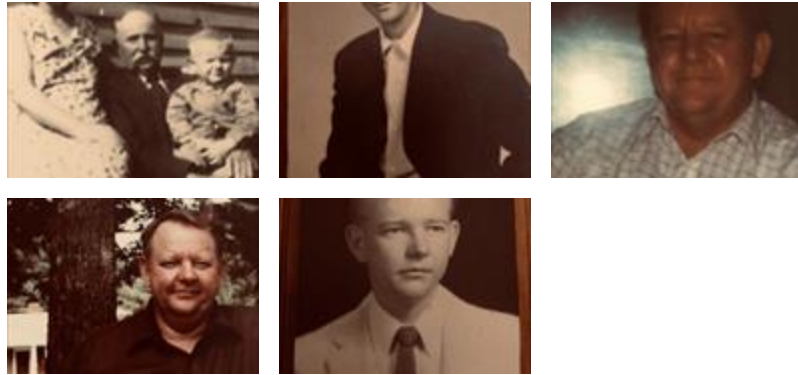


“ Dear Brendeee,
