Lyman, SC – Neil Leo Bloomfield, Jr., 84, passed away peacefully at his home with his wife, Betty McElfresh Bloomfield, at his side, on November 14th, 2024.

For the last 19 years, he's lived on Lyman Lake, where he and Betty became well-liked "Lake People". He enjoyed the camaraderie and social life the lake provided, as well as the occasional fishing when hunting permitted.

In addition to his wife, Neil is survived by his sisters and their husbands, Carol (John) Darr, and Marilyn (David) Polanco; his 4 children, and their spouses, Lisa (Scott) Champine, Pete (Nancy) Stalnaker, Kristi (Carl) Kurtz, and Mandy
