Duncan – Robert Gurdon Neubacher, 81, of Duncan, passed away July 10, 2024. He was the loving husband of Lenore Elaine Neubacher for 59 years and the son of the late Emil and Ruth Neubacher.

A native of Geneva, Ohio, Mr. Neubacher proudly served in the United States Navy during the Vietnam Era. He grew up with a family in the grocery business and worked in all aspects of the family owned stores, most often as a meat cutter. An opportunity in the travel trailer industry brought him and his family to the south, working for several local companies. Mr. Neubacher's last career brought his love of people and travel together as a driver for Jean's Tours and Travel.
