She was a beloved daughter, wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother who during her professional career was a secretary, teacher and librarian. Upon Virgil's transfer to Boca Raton, FL, the family moved to Lighthouse Point, FL and while Virgil continued designing early computers Shirley taught Montessori to pre-schoolers and became a librarian at the Lighthouse Point Library from where she retired in 1989 after 20 years of service. Upon Virgil's passing in 1998 Shirley relocated to northern Virginia with her two youngest daughters. Shirley loved young children and made a difference teaching Montessori students and children's reading sessions at the library. She and Virgil loved to travel and took their kids on several cross-country trips and to Canada. She and Virgil passed on their passion for the outdoors to their children who also have a passion for hiking, gardening and fishing.

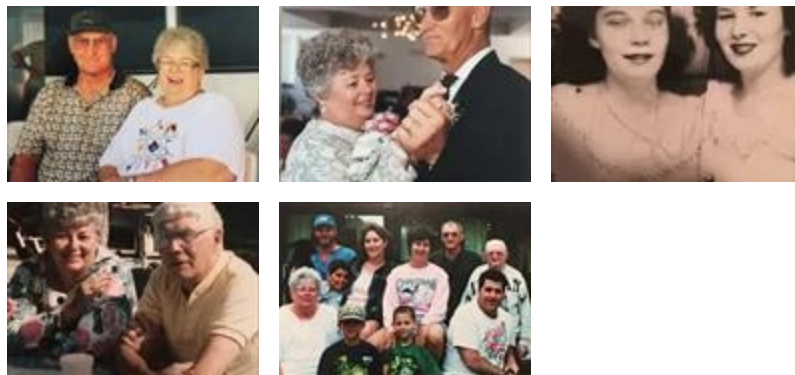
